SFPS Summer Programs

At Santa Fe Public Schools we believe that every child should have the opportunity to participate in high-quality summer programs that both increase learning and offer fun, innovative enrichment activities. It is a SFPS priority to keep our students exploring, discovering, and growing over the summer.

Research shows that students forget things that they have learned if they do not use their brainpower over the summer. Summer programs provide additional practice in academic skills as well as introducing students to new and different learning experiences that may not be available during the school year.

SFPS offers two types of summer programs: Summer Schools, which offer regular school classes, and Summer Enrichment Programs, which offer a variety of other learning experiences. Programs are scheduled at different times throughout the summer so students can participate in more than one. For families that need full-time childcare, a partnership with the Boys and Girls Club (474-0385) enables students to participate in SFPS programs part-time and Boys and Girls Club part-time.

K-3 Plus (Grades K-3)

Students who participate in the K-3 Plus program benefit from 25 free additional days of school. Students in K-3 Plus attend school during the regular school hours and receive academic instruction, extracurricular activities, breakfast, lunch, and transportation just as they do during the school year. Summer School (Grades 3-8)

Any elementary or middle school student grades 3-8 in Santa Fe Public Schools can attend Summer School. Reading and math will be the focus of Summer School instruction. Summer school runs from **May 31-June 24** from 8:00 am-12:30 pm. This year Summer School will be held at Gonzales Community School. Free breakfast and lunch are provided.
